Chapter 13:8-9

Jesus Washes the Disciples' Feet (Jesus Humbled Himself)

8 “No,” Peter protested, “you will never ever wash my feet!”

Jesus replied, “Unless I wash you, you won't belong to me.”

9 Simon Peter exclaimed, “Then wash my hands and head as well, Lord, not just my feet!”

1 Peter 5:6-7

6 So humble yourselves under the mighty power of God, and at the right time he will lift you up in honor. 7 Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you.

Chapter 13:21;27

One of you will betray me! (Be Alert)

21 Now Jesus was deeply troubled, and he exclaimed, “I tell you the truth, one of you will betray me!”

27 When Judas had eaten the bread, Satan entered into him. Then Jesus told him, “Hurry and do what you're going to do.”

1 Peter 5:8-9

Chapter 13:34-35

A New Commandment

34 So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. 35 Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples.”

1 John 3:16-18

Chapter 13:37-38

Peter's Denials (Deception)

37 "But why can't I come now, Lord?" he asked. "I'm ready to die for you."

38 Jesus answered, "Die for me? I tell you the truth, Peter—before the rooster crows tomorrow morning, you will deny three times that you even know me."

Mt 26:69-75 (3 times)

69 Meanwhile, Peter was sitting outside in the courtyard. A servant girl came over and said to him, "You were one of those with Jesus the Galilean."

70 But Peter denied it in front of everyone. "I don't know what you're talking about," he said.

71 Later, out by the gate, another servant girl noticed him and said to those standing around, "This man was with Jesus of Nazareth."

72 Again Peter denied it, this time with an oath. "I don't even know the man," he said.

73 A little later some of the other bystanders came over to Peter and said, "You must be one of them; we can tell by your Galilean accent."

74 Peter swore, "A curse on me if I'm lying—I don't know the man!" And immediately the rooster crowed.

75 Suddenly, Jesus' words flashed through Peter's mind: "Before the rooster crows, you will deny three times that you even know me." And he went away, weeping bitterly.

Jesus, the Way to the Father

Chapter 14:1

¹ “Don’t let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me.”

The Way, The Truth and the Life

⁶ Jesus told him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.

Greater Works

Chapter 14:12-14

¹² “I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even **greater works**, because I am going to be with the Father. ¹³ You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. ¹⁴ Yes, ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it!

Chapter 14 - To Tell the Truth

Jesus Promises the Holy Spirit

Chapter 14:15-17

15 “If you love me, obey my commandments. 16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you. 17 He is the Holy Spirit, who leads into all truth. The world cannot receive him, because it isn’t looking for him and doesn’t recognize him. But you know him, because he lives with you now and later will be in you.

Jesus Said Because I Live

Chapter 14:19-20

19 Soon the world will no longer see me, but you will see me. **Since I live, you also will live.** 20 When I am raised to life again, you will know that I am in my Father, and you are in me, and I am in you.

Advocate as my Representative

Chapter 14:25-26

25 I am telling you these things now while I am still with you. 26 But when the Father sends the **Advocate as my representative**—that is, the Holy Spirit—he will **teach** you everything and will **remind** you of everything I have told you.

Chapter 15 - If You Abide in Me

John 15:4-5

4 Remain in me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful unless you remain in me.

5 “Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing.

John 15:7-8

7 But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted! 8 When you produce much fruit, you are my true disciples. This brings great glory to my Father.

John 15:16

16 You didn't choose me. I chose you. I appointed you to go and produce lasting fruit, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask for, using my name.

John 15:26-27

26 “But I will send you the Advocate the Spirit of truth. He will come to you from the Father and will testify all about me. 27 And you must also testify about me because you have been with me from the beginning of my ministry.

Ro 8:14-17

14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God.

15 So you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when he adopted you as his own children. Now we call him, “Abba, Father.” 16 For his Spirit joins with our spirit to affirm that we are God's children. 17 And since we are his children, we are his heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory. But if we are to share his glory, we must also share his suffering.
